For example, if your organization begins its annual pay calendar on January 1, 2020 (the January 1 date is required, since earnings are reported to the IRS for the January 1-through-December 31 calendar year), the first pay period for that year would likely be Monday, January 1- through-Sunday, January 12, with the first payday of 2020 being Friday, January 17, if you don't hold back two weeks ...

A "work week" is a recurring period of seven consecutive days selected by the employer for the purpose of scheduling work, or if the employer has not selected such a period, a recurring period of seven consecutive days beginning on Sunday and ending on Saturday. Leave Year Beginning and Ending Dates

The University of Minnesota pays employees biweekly. Each pay period starts on a Monday and ends on a Sunday. Employees are paid every other Wednesday, 10 days after the end of the pay period. For example, under a given agency's payroll cycle, the biweekly pay period covering December 24, 2017, through January 6, 2018, may be the first biweekly pay period with a payroll pay date in calendar year 2018.
