The New Jersey Hospital Care Payment Assistance Program (Charity Care) is available to patients for inpatient and outpatient services at all acute care hospitals throughout New Jersey. Medically necessary services may be eligible for patients who meet income and asset criteria. Applications are available at all NJ acute care hospitals.

NJ Department of Health SFY2020 Charity Care Subsidy ...

The State of New Jersey has a Charity Care Program for individuals who have little to no insurance. This program helps pay some or all of a recipient's hospital expenses. This includes emergency room visits, hospital stays and testing done as an outpatient. The amount of help an individual receives with these bills depends on their income.

How to Apply for Charity Care in New Jersey | Pocketsense

NJ FamilyCare covers: children, pregnant women, parents/caretaker relatives, and single adults/childless couples. Children 18 and under are eligible with higher incomes up to 355% FPL (\$7,751/month for a family of four). Parents still need to renew the coverage each year. Parents/Caretaker Relatives with income up to 138% FPL (\$3,013/month for a family of four) must have tax dependent children in their household in order to be eligible under this category.

NJ FamilyCare - Income Eligibility and Cost

If your family income is below 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, you may be eligible for one of the low income assistance programs (e.g., Medicaid or Charity Care).

Financial Assistance Program - St. Joseph's Health

Charity Care and Uninsured. If you require Public Assistance or Charity Care, advise the registration personnel or contact the Financial Counselor at 856.342.3140 to set up an appointment. If you are uninsured or underinsured, you may qualify for a reduction of your billed charges.

If the patient earns 250% or less than the federal poverty guidelines, that patient is eligible for 100% financial assistance and for UPMC service fees to be waived.

Charity Care - Eligibility

If patient on the >200% to <=300% sliding fee scale for NJ Funded Charity Care,are responsible for qualified out-of-pocket paid medical expenses in excess of 30% of their gross annual income, then the amount in excess of 30% is considered hospital payment assistance(NJ funded Charity Care) 5 6

Applying For Charity Care. Visit a hospital in your area. If possible, visit a not-for-profit hospital. Ask the front desk staff about the hospital's charity-care program. How to Apply for Charity Care - Health FAQ

In accordance with Charity Care guidelines, payment assistance is available to New Jersey resident patients whose household gross income is at or below 300% of the federal poverty guidelines and who: Have no health coverage or have coverage that pays only for part of the bill; and; Are ineligible for any private or governmental sponsored coverage (such as Medicaid); and ; Meet both the income and assets eligibility criteria as follows:
