The Digestive System and Body Metabolism: How They Work ...

Before you take that first bite of food, hunger and appetite work together to prepare the digestive tract for digestion. The nervous system stimulates the release of digestive juices before food even enters our mouth. Once you take a bite of food, digestion begins in the mouth. Chewing is referred to as mechanical digestion.
