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Nursery Education And Grant Maintained

(1) This Act may be cited as the Nursery Education and Grant-Maintained Schools Act 1996. (2) This Act shall be construed as one with the Education Act 1996. (3) The provisions of this Act shall come into force on such day as the Secretary of State may by order appoint; and different days may be appointed for different provisions and for different purposes.

History. Grant-maintained status was created by the Education Reform Act 1988, as part of the programme of the Conservative government to create greater diversity in educational provision and to weaken the influence of local education authorities.. The concept of grant maintained schools was introduced by the Education Reform Act 1988. This allowed schools which had been maintained by a Local Education Authority (LEA) to 'opt out' of the LEA's control and receive their funding via grants from the central government.
