If you're wondering how much paracord you need for a snake knot. You'll need about 5.5 inches of paracord for every 1 inch of Snake Knot you want to have. So if you wanted to make a bracelet and want to know how much paracord for a snake knot bracelet. Here's a general rule: 1 inch of bracelet length = 1 foot of cord

Paracord Snake Knot: How To Make Bracelets, Lanyards, and ...

Take the cord on the left side and place it under the center strands running between the buckle ends. Now take the cord on the right side under the left side cord, over the center strands, and thru the loop of the left side cord. Tighten up the cords so the half knot you just formed is next to the buckle.

Paracord Bracelet With a Side Release Buckle : 9 Steps ...

To create the first pass, tie a bowline between the two bottom most background strands. Using an overhand knot, tie those two background strands together. The foreground strand will always stay between the two background strands. Making these knots uniform is the most important part of the hammock!

To make a paracord bracelet, fold your cord in half and pull the loop through one side of the buckle. Pull the ends to make a knot, then pull them through the other side of the buckle. Adjust the second buckle so the bracelet fits around your wrist, then fold the ends back.
